Free Training on US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) *Aircraft Reporting and Compliance System (ARCS)*

TRAINING DESCRIPTION

US EPA developed the *Aircraft Reporting and Compliance System (ARCS)* to facilitate the electronic reporting of aircraft public water system (PWS) data, pursuant to the Aircraft Drinking Water Rule (ADWR) [40 CFR Part 141 Subpart X (74 Federal Register 53590; October 19, 2009)].

ARCS is a centralized web-based data collection and management system that performs logic checks on data entered, and calculates final results for accountability and regulatory oversight (including issuance of potential violations).

Free training is being offered to the regulated community via a Live Webcast on January 22 and 29, 2013.

ARCS Training will include a web-based interactive demonstration of:

- How to access via EPA-issued UserID and Password, and the electronic signature process
- How to enter data via batch load spreadsheets or the Web User Interface
- How to electronically sign data
- How to correct data after electronically signing or reset data before electronically signing
- How to enter data for aircraft PWS that are INACTIVE (i.e., not in passenger service or on international route)
- Types of violations generated for ADWR non-compliance
- How certified Labs (as approved by the air carrier) can enter sampling data
- And other enhanced functions (e.g., Restrict Public Access)
