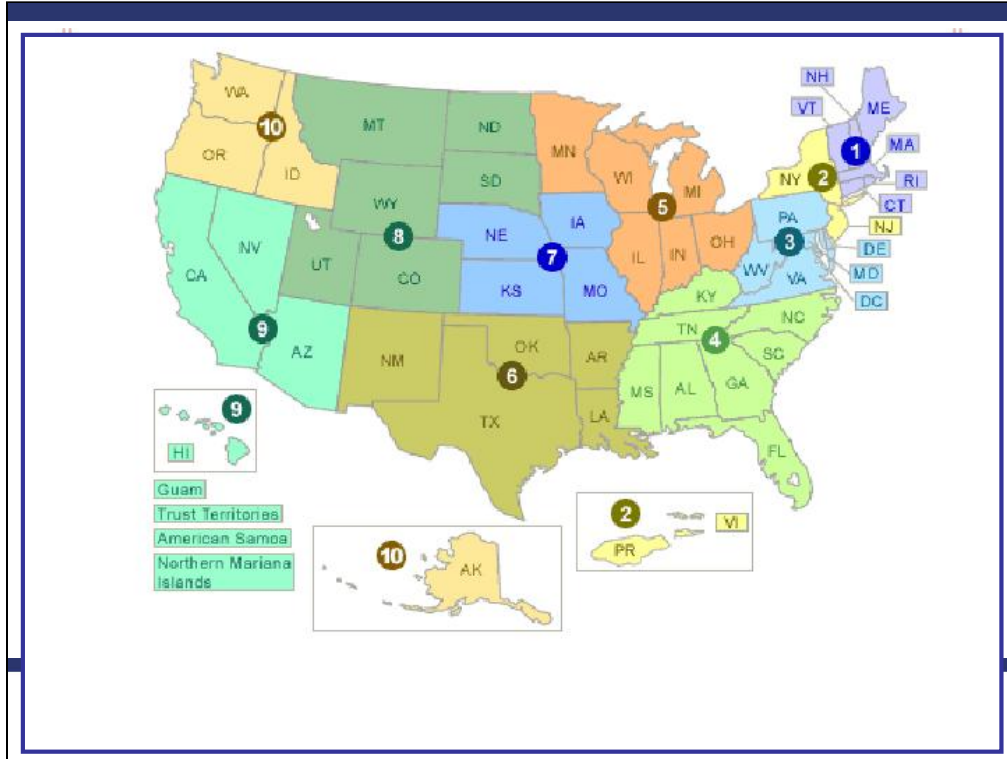
Focus audience will be those tribes with more advanced 319 programs to implement their NPS Management Program. Watershed-based planning concepts will also be highlighted.
